Administrative Support Needed for Growing Medical Clinic Programs

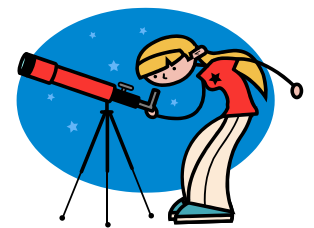

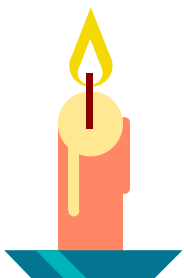


October 18th Organ concert by our Danny Wesley Ray at 2:30 in Family Hall on the theatre organ in conjunction with the Dallas Organ Society.
