

## Dallas Christian Women's Job Corps

Paulette Harrison has been volunteering at Dallas Christian Women's Job Corps (DCWJC) since 2004, when she heard 3 graduates of the program speak at a Women of the Church dinner. As a retired educator and administrator in public schools, she saw this as an opportunity to use her training and to “invest in the lives of women who are striving for a better future”.

DCWJC exists to “help women through our Job Readiness and Life Skills Program - an 8 week class, free of charge, focused on developing job and life skills for all women.” Paulette and Sandy Washington both teach a class once a week.

The greatest need right now is for mentors who agree to get to know and stay in touch with graduates for a minimum of 6 months. After graduating, mentors provide support as graduates navigate life without the supportive environment of the program.
